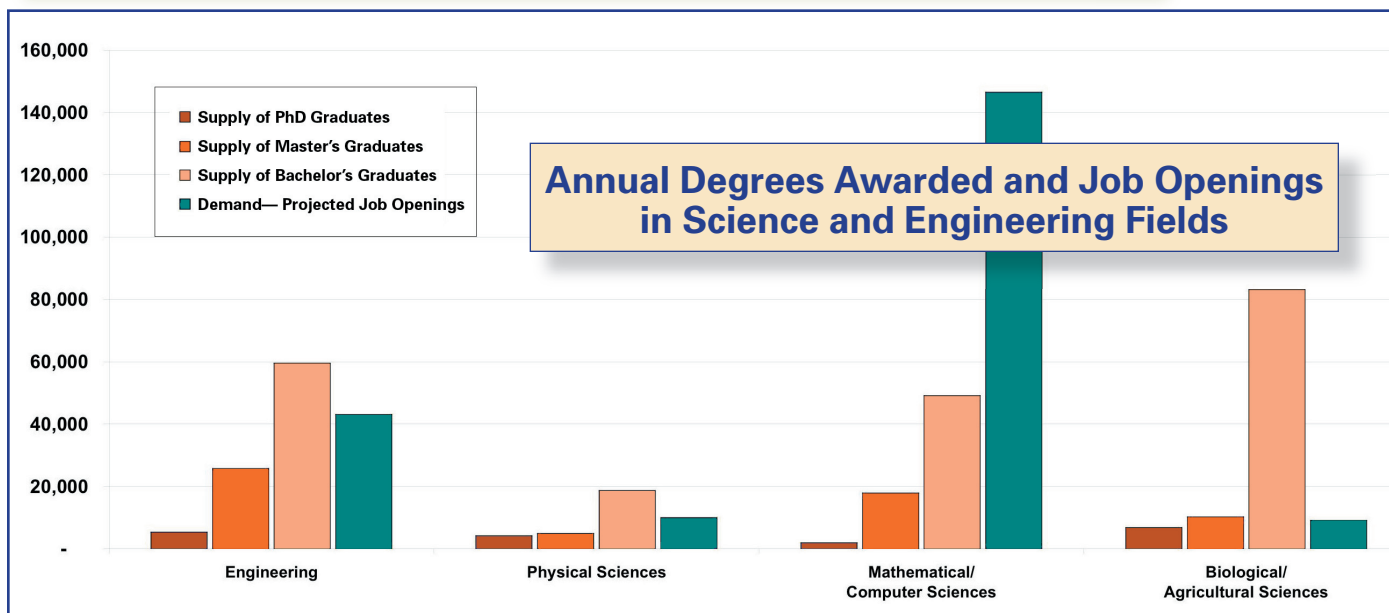
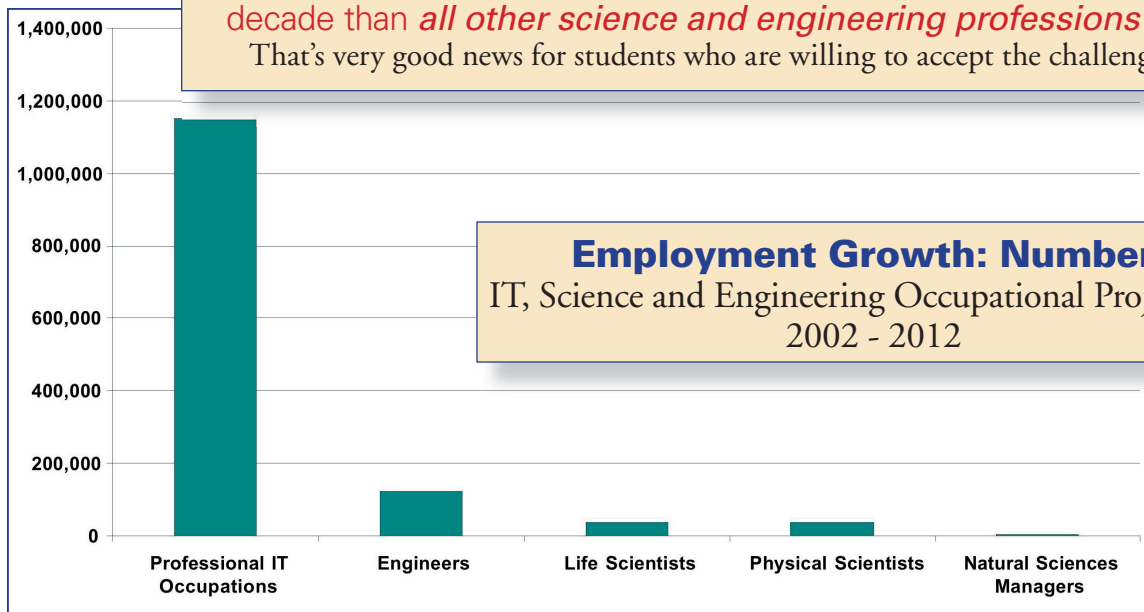


# Reality Check. Demand for CS Grads Far Exceeds Supply.
