

## How to make an iPhone App

You need an Intel-based Mac running snow leopard or later

1. Go to <http://developer.apple.com/>
2. Click on the “iPhone Dev Center Link”
  - a. This should take you to <http://developer.apple.com/iphone/index.action>
3. Register to become an apple developer (this is free)
4. Then login and return to the iPhone Dev Center
5. Click on the iPhone SDK link
6. Then download the newest versions of Xcode and the iPhone SDK
  - a. This has all the programs you need to create your app like Xcode, iPhone Simulator, Interface Builder, and Instruments
7. Install what you have downloaded
8. Begin writing your app
9. If you want your app to be published, join the iPhone Developer Program (<http://developer.apple.com/programs/iphone/>)
10. Pay the \$99
  - a. By joining you are also able to give 100 iphones/ipod touches/ ipads a copy of your app for free
11. Submit your app to the app store

There also is the option of joining the iPhone Developer Enterprise Program which costs \$299 to join and enables you to develop, design and deploy in-house applications to employees within your company
